Volleyball Scoring

Line up Sheet - 1 per match

- List of players & uniform numbers / cross out players not present
- Coach(s) sign
- Photocopy master with all team members and numbers, plus coach(s) signatures
- Before each game, write in player numbers in order as they will appear on the court at the start of the game
- Circle first server / mark C for Floor Captain

Score sheet - 1 per game

Before Game

- Document team names on correct side/ game number/ have Ref sign
- Home team official book Ref will use score sheet or lineup sheet to check lineup
- Mark team for first service
- In PLAYERS NUMBERS column write service order (uniform number), mark Floor Captain with C

For each serve

- For (before)each serve make circle
- After play watch ref for result they will indicate who will receive point
- If serving team is getting point:
 - o fill in circle with point number scored
 - o and mark running score with circle.
- If non-serving team is getting point:
 - o fill circle with R (for rotate)
 - o place point number without circle under non-serving teams score
 - o mark running score with a slash
- Change color at end of 1 full rotation by both teams ie., Blue / red / blue
- Check often with other team's book and flip scorer / scoreboard question differences ASAP, involve ref if needed!

Substitutions / Timeouts

- Time outs record in Time Outs box under team that takes time out, place score 2 per team per game
- Substitutions place in score before next service circle
 - For serving team write S in/out ie. S 7/15
 - For receiving team Sx in/out ie. Sx 13/2.
 - Cross out player number write in new player number
 - Player must return to same spot in service order!!
 - Cross out running substitution number max per game -12

Notes

- Younger teams (5th&6th) 5 serve in a row max per server let ref know, serving team rotates
- Point Game -- let ref know
- Circle final score of game / note in boxes
 - 3 minutes between games
- Scoring Exceptions Ref mind change M / corrections cross out RARE
- Refs are helpful OK to ask them questions, they will work with you
