

The Travel High School Basketball Program, organized by CYOLI, is a competitive opportunity for athletes committed to enhancing their basketball skills and competing at a higher level. Commitment is essential, as players will need to travel to various Parishes across Nassau and Suffolk counties for games. Players must meet the CYOLI Travel eligibility requirements. For more information on eligibility, please contact the main office at office@strosecyo.org.

Registration opens on August 4, 2025, and closes on August 25, 2025. To submit a team, coaches must do so within this timeframe. Additionally, coaches should email St. Rose CYO at office@strosecyo.org to confirm CYOLI eligibility support.

Registration Details:

- The head coach must submit a complete roster of at least 10 players and no more than 12 players to St. Rose CYO.
- It's important that all players are committed to the program and meet CYOLI Travel eligibility.
- Only the head coach can register the entire team on the St. Rose CYO website at <u>www.strosecyo.org</u>. During registration, the head coach will need to provide the name and email address of each player.
- Once registration is complete, the system will send an email to each player with an invitation to join the team.
- Players must follow the instructions in the email and click the provided link to finalize their registration. Players should NOT go to the website to register directly.

Team Divisions:

- Division eligibility is determined based on the grade levels of the players on the team.
 - Tyro Division: For players in Grade 9 or Grade 10, or a combination of Grades 9 and 10.
 - **Senior Division:** Primarily for players in Grade 11 or Grade 12, or a combination of Grades 11 and 12. However, players in Grades 9 and 10 may also participate in the Senior Division if needed. Teams must compete in the Senior Division if they include at least one player in Grade 11 or 12.

Season:

- September through November.
- Games scheduled by CYOLI.
- Practices scheduled by the head coach as needed.

Payment:

- The head coach is responsible for collecting the \$1,800 team fee. This fee covers uniforms, equipment, and other program expenses.
- The fee must be collected by the team's first practice or no later than September 12, 2025.
- Payment can be made via check (payable to St. Rose CYO), cash, or a combination of both.

Uniform Information:

- Jerseys: Provided by St. Rose CYO.
- Shorts: Players must wear solid black shorts, which should be purchased by the player.
